We have started work on an Action Plan that will result in an official Deer Lake Management Plan, which can be used to garner grants for water projects. To amplify that effort, we are seeking community partners to form a "Deer Lake Clean Water Collaborative".

Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) continue to threaten Deer Lake. Because of all the hard surfaces in the lake together with the high calcium content of the water, we are a high-risk lake for Zebra Mussels. And there are many more such unwelcome invaders on the horizon. Some of these can seriously ruin the lake for angling, boating, swimming and general livability...not to mention our property values. We all must remain vigilant! The County AIS program's access inspectors can do only so much: it is up to all of us to take personal responsibility and keep our guests well aware of the situation.

For all these reasons your membership is critical to the DLA's mission to provide and protect our recreational opportunities and still pristine environment. Please join or renew your DLA membership by May 1 in order to take full advantage of our summer initiatives, activities, and communications. It's only \$25 per family.
