Margaret Kelly Brown Margaret (Peg) Kelly Brown, 98, of San Luis Obispo died Thursday, November 24th, 2016. Mrs. Brown was born June 28, 1918 to the Rev. and Mrs. Albert Kelly in Pawnee City, Nebraska. She moved six times in the next fourteen years, arriving in Santa

Ana, CA in 1933. She graduated from Santa Ana High School in 1935, with a lifetime membership in The California Scholastic Federation. She took an accelerated Business course at the local Junior College the next year. 'She went to Tarkio College in Missouri in 1936, from which she graduated in 1940, Magna Cum Laude. there for 60 years, moving to San Luis Obispo in 2001. Sam passed away in 2002. They were married for 60 years. She was a woman of quiet dignity, kindness, strength and faith and a friend to anyone who needed it. Peg was an active member of San Luis Obispo Methodist Church where she was on several boards and involved in many women's groups. She was a member of Chapter SO of the P.E.O. Sisterhood, Bookworms Book Group, SLOUMC Book Group, 3 bridge groups and the Laguna Lake Ladies Golf League. She was an avid golfer and played golf twice a week. Survivors include her three sons, Sam, Jr. (Alison), Aspen, CO, Tom (Pamela), San Luis Obispo, CA and Jim (Jeff), Key West, FL. two siblings, John Kelly of San Luis Obispo and Mary Wolf of Minerva, OH, six grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
