14 primary issues in this site is that it looks to be
15 very, very good loon nesting habitat and probably
16 important spawning area. And I think that northern
17 little bit, number one there, stands to be a little
18 bit too exposed to those island and nesting areas to
19 be able to have that kind of traffic going in and out,
20 without impacting loon nesting, spawning, and other
21 ecological functions there. I do believe you can put
22 in a septic system that could cope with waste and keep
23 it from the lake, you know, that's my personal
24 feeling, if it's done correctly, but I don't think
25 there should be traffic in and out right there.
